Does the program have the capability to provide net present value and amortizations of Alimony? If yes, how do I prepare such?

Yes:

There is an icon called Computational Tools (Red Hammer). The Annuity Estimator on that school can be filled out to give the net present value of any annuity. Alimony is an annuity. Just enter the number of months, the alimony amount (suggest after tax amount to get real value), suggested discount rate (rate that you expect you can get return on lump sum to produce this income flow (I use between 3 and 4% these days). This will provide the net present value of this flow of alimony.
